CLASS ENROLLMENT POLICIES:

1. You may enroll in person at our store or you may call us at 707 996 2323
2. Payment must be made in full at the time of class registration. Deadline for enrollment is 3 days prior to the class. We accept: Cash, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover and Checks.
3. Our Classes are for ages 12 and up. No children or guests are allowed to attend class sessions with you. "Kids Classes" are for the child only. No parents or guests are allowed. If the parent wishes to attend the class with the child an additional class fee will be charged.

CANCELLATIONS:

1. Refunds will not be issued unless we cancel the class. We reserve the right to cancel because of low registration. We will notify class participants of a cancelled class 72 hours or sooner and you will receive a full refund or store credit.
2. Should you cancel your class we require a 3 day notice (72 hours) to receive full credit toward a future class. Cancellations after 72 hours up to 24 hours before class will receive 1/2 fee credit toward a future class.
3. On occasion we will have guest teachers. These instructors teach nationally and go through great expense to travel to our store. Cancellations for guest teacher will not be refunded.

MATERIALS FEES:

An itemized materials list will be provided for each class at enrollment. Materials and tools are not included in the class fee unless specified. Material for classes must be purchased at our store. You may bring your own tools. If you do not have tools you will need purchase them. We do not loan tools. If we do not carry an item we will let you know where it can be purchased. We offer 10% off on class material on class day. Kits, sale items and tools excluded.
